The War in Vietnam

This revision activity works best if you do it with a friend, and talk about it as you do it.

This simple game will familiarise you with the events, and help you remember the dates.

Print off (on card or thick paper) & cut out the cards below, shuffle and lay them out face down randomly on the table. In turn, each player turns over two cards (one small, one large); if they have a date card which matches its events card, they keep the 'trick', if not, they replace both cards face down in their exact place. on the table. The winner is the player with most pairs ('tricks') at the end of the game.

For a harder game, lay out the date+events cards in date order. Ask one player to leave and remove an agreed number of cards. Invite them to return and remember the missing information.

1937	1937: Chinese Communist leader Mao Zedong wrote <i>On Guerrilla Warfare</i>
1954	1954: The Geneva Agreement divided Vietnam into a Communist north (led by Communist leader Ho Chi Minh) and a 'democratic' south led by Ngo Dinh Diem
1960	1960: The Communist National Liberation Front (the 'Vietcong') restarted a guerrilla war to conquer South Vietnam
October 1963	October 1963: A Buddhist monk named Thich Quang Duc burned himself to death in protest at the Diem government's persecution of Buddhism
November 1963	November 1963: The CIA arranged a military coup, and Diem was assassinated

August 1964	August 1964: The USS <i>Maddox</i> in the Gulf of Tonkin claimed it had been attacked; Congress passed the Gulf of Tonkin Resolution
February 1965 - November 1968	February 1965 - November 1968: The VC attacked American air bases; Johnson ordered Operation Rolling Thunder
1966	1966: Operation Crimp tried to destroy the Cu Chi tunnels
November 1965	November 1965: General William Westmoreland lured in the NVA at la Drang, then destroyed them with a massive air strike
January-March 1968	January-March 1968: The Tet Offensive
March 1968	March 1968: My Lai Massacre by Charlie Company of the 23rd Infantry Division, led by Second Lieutenant William Calley
1968-1972	1968-72: Operation Phoenix – the CIA arrested and interrogated suspected VC
